The Great Trailer Park Rescue of 2023

In early 2023, one of our volunteers set out on an impressive mission to clean up the stray cat population in a local mobile home park in Stoutsville, Ohio. Dozens of stray cats and kittens were roaming this neighborhood, and some were sick or injured. Our volunteer saw an opportunity to prevent overpopulation through TNR. What she didn't expect was to find many of these cats and kittens were friendly! Forgotten 4-Paws brought ALL of the animals into our care to find them homes. As a result of our volunteer's effort, 27 cats were rescued. At the time of this update, 14 of them have found loving homes. We are still working to rescue the remaining cats. None of the kittens or cats will be returned to this horrific situation. Loving barn homes are still needed

for the cats that are feral. This is just one example of how your donations allow our volunteers to help animals in need! This project had a huge impact on the mobile home community as it halted the overpopulation problem that would have continued had she not stepped in. It also ensured that the cats and kittens that were rescued would have loving forever homes and would never have to fend for themselves again!!!
